

The F.B. and Robbie Shelby Herron Memorial Citizenship Award

The F.B. and Robbie Shelby Herron Memorial Citizenship Award will be awarded to a male graduating senior. A personalized plaque and \$300 monetary award will be presented on BMHS' Awards Night. This award will be selected by Peggie Herron Miller and the Herron family based on essays and faculty recommendations.

To apply for the award, a student must:

- Exemplify good American citizenship in all areas of life.
- Have no major disciplinary action from school authorities or law enforcement.
- Possess a scholastic average of B; not necessarily be a candidate for athletic or academic scholarship.
- Exhibit respect for American ideals of hard work, self-reliance, and patriotism.
- Display respect for self and others.
- Have excellent attendance and effort in all school subjects.

Requirements to apply:

- Essay written by the applying student on the subject, "My Personal Role in Keeping America Great." This essay of approximately 250 words must exhibit sincerity and general competence in written English.
- Short recommendation letters from three teachers of core subjects (English, math, science or history).

Deadline to submit is March 29.
